- (2) That the Commission determine the price to be paid for said right of way.



Upon the foregoing petition, filed March 22, 1954; it is

ORDERED, that a hearing thereon be held before said Public Utilities Commission at its office in Concord, Room 208, State House Annex, in said State, at ten-thirty o'clock in the forenoon on the twenty-third day of April, 1954; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED, that said Public Service Company of New Hampshire shall give public notice thereof to the owner of the lands described in said petition, to appear at said hearing when and where he may be heard relative to the necessity for the rights prayed for, and the compensation to be paid therefor, if said petition shall be granted, by causing an attested copy of this order and of said petition incorporated herein, to be given in hand to said owner, or left at his last and usual place of abode, not less than fourteen days before said hearing.
