**MCKENNA’S PURCHASE –
MOTION TO JOIN IN MOTION FOR REHEARING**

NOW COMES McKenna’s Purchase, by and through its attorneys, Wadleigh, Starr & Peters, P.L.L.C., and says as follows by way of this Motion to Join in Motion for Rehearing:

The Deerfield Intervenors have, on or about the same date that this pleading is being filed, submitted a Motion for Rehearing pursuant to RSA 541:3 (the “Motion”), in which they have thoroughly and convincingly explained the various ways in which the Public Utilities Commission (the “Commission”) erred in its April 6, 2017 Order. Because the arguments raised in the Motion apply with equal force to McKenna’s Purchase, there is no need to repeat the arguments raised therein. Accordingly, McKenna’s Purchase fully joins in the Motion and requests that the Commission reconsider its Order. In the event that the Commission decides against granting the Motion, McKenna’s Purchase requests an opportunity to exercise its reserved right to contest, pursuant to the rule of reason, the rights granted under the lease from Eversource to NPT.


